Students will not be registered for the 6-Credits of Internship Courses until they have a signed internship agreement. An internship must last a minimum of 40 weeks. Students logging hours are required to attend virtual monthly internship seminars for as long as they are logging hours even after the initial registration semester. Non-Alfred Alumni are required to go to Alfred University's campus for a 4-day seminar July 19th – 22nd, 2026.

A minimum of 60 graduate credits is required for Mental Health Licensure in New York State. Students may be required to take more than the 18-credits above based on their previous graduate coursework. All transcripts will be reviewed during the admissions process.
